
Temporary suspension of vehicle revenue licenses issued by Divisional Secretariats

It is the responsibility of all government agencies to take all the necessary steps to prevent the public from gathering in groups to minimize the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) virus. I hereby request to suspend the issuance of vehicle revenue licenses by Divisional Secretariats from today (17.03.2020) to 31st March 2020.

2. Accordingly, hereby instructed all Divisional Secretariats including the Department of Motor Traffic not to issue vehicle revenue licenses or related services until 31.03.2020. However, since the online service has expanded the revenue licensing service, it has the potential to issue revenue licenses.

3. Further, issuing Revenue License will not be subject to arrears and fines for the period suspended by the Divisional Secretariats. I also advise the license holders to use the online service to minimize the inconvenience incurred by the Divisional Secretariat.

4. The Sri Lanka Police will be notified to provide relief on Highway Inspections for persons who delay in obtaining relevant revenue licenses up to 31st March 2020.
